Free-Standing Emergency Room

Free-Standing Emergency Rooms offer emergency room service in a facility separate from a hospital. These Free-Standing Emergency Rooms are required to have basically the same levels of staffing and service as a hospital-based emergency room. They treat the most serious needs first, so you might have a long wait if you don't have an emergency. For true emergencies, they accept all types of insurance, but for non-emergencies, you may end up paying significantly more for care. Costs are higher because of the higher-level of staffing and services required. Your health insurance co-pays may be much higher at these facilities.

You go to a hospital if you have a serious medical condition, are being admitted to the hospital for a procedure or if you are having a life-or-limb-threatening emergency, call 9-1-1 to get to the nearest emergency room. An emergency room is not the best place to go for non-emergency health needs. You may face long waiting times and much higher costs.




Each Cherry Creek school has a homeless liaison & family advocate
